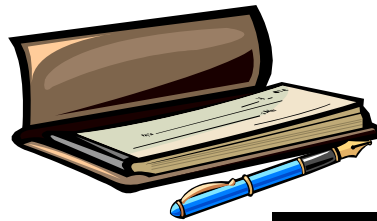

This replaces the Child Abuse Prevention Training—Managed by Ohio's ESC e-Learning Collaborative

The Ohio Department of Education (ODE) and the Ohio Department of Mental Health worked with Justice Evelyn Stratton of the Ohio Supreme Court in conceptualizing the Safety and Violence Prevention Curriculum training. The Ohio Suicide Prevention Foundation and the Interprofessional Commission of Ohio played instrumental roles in writing the curriculum and in soliciting input from more than 30 state and local agencies, universities, schools, and associations.

The online training meets new requirements of state law stipulating that all pre-kindergarten through grade 12 (pre-K to 12) school professionals take four hours of training in child abuse recognition; violence and substance abuse prevention; positive youth development; and teen dating and violence by **OCTOBER 17, 2011**, and every five years thereafter (Ohio Revised Code Section 3319.073).

The Five Modules:

Module 1: Mental and Behavioral Health Issues in Students

Module 2: Depression and Suicide

Module 3: Alcohol and Drug Abuse and Addiction

Module 4: Violence Against Children

Module 5: Teen Dating Violence Prevention
